AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF MOBILE SCHEDULE OF LICENSES, PROVISIONS IN CHAPTER 30 RELATED TO THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, AND PROVISIONS IN CHAPTER 34 RELATED TO DELINQUENT PAYMENTS

Sponsored By: William S. Stimpson, Mayor

WHEREAS, the City of Mobile ("City") wishes to update its Schedule of Licenses to clarify the types of licenses available, incorporate changes in State law and licensing procedures, and eliminate superfluous license provisions;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to amend Chapter 30 to clarify the procedures related to alcoholic beverage licenses;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to amend Chapter 34 to incorporate changes in State law related to delinquent payments and issuing fees; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is enacted to accomplish said goals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOBILE, ALABAMA, that the following Ordinance is adopted to amend the "Schedule of Licenses" located in Chapter 34, of the Code of the City of Mobile, Alabama, 1991, as well as the below amendments and additions to Chapter 30, of the Code of the City of Mobile, Alabama, 1991, and to Chapter 34, of the Code of the City of Mobile, Alabama, 1991 as follows:

<u>Section 2</u>: Section 30-71, of the Mobile City Code, 1991, is hereby amended and restated to read as follows:

Sec. 30-71. - Application for license; deposit of fee; approval by health officer; designation of place of business.

Each person applying for a license to sell the beverages defined in section 30-1 shall make application therefor on a form similar in all respects to the form required for the application for state licenses under Code of Alabama, Section 28-3-1 et seq., as amended, and such forms shall contain the same statement of facts required under such state law for state applications. A non-refundable application fee of \$50.00 is to be included with each application. No such license shall be issued until the applicant has been duly licensed by the state and no application for a state license shall be approved until an application for the city license has been made and the sum required for the issuance of the city license has been deposited with the city revenue department. In the event the state license is refused, the sum so deposited shall be immediately returned to the applicant. No application for a state license shall be approved nor shall a city license be issued for the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises until the applicant deposits with the city revenue department a certificate by the health officer that the premises in question are sanitary and properly equipped for compliance with the state and city sanitary and health laws. Every license issued shall designate the place at which such business shall be carried on and such license shall authorize the carrying on of such business only at the place designated.

Section 3: Section 30-76, of Mobile City Code, 1991, is hereby amended and restated to read as follows:

Sec. 30-76. – Reserved License nonassignable; transfer.

Licenses issued to sell the beverages defined in section 30-1 may not be assigned but the city is hereby authorized to transfer any license from one person to another or from one place to another, as the city council may determine. No transfer shall be made to a person who would not have been eligible to receive the license originally nor for the transaction of business at a place for which the license could not originally have been issued hereunder. Before the transfer is made, the person seeking the transfer shall file an application on the form of application required to be filed by the licensee, the filled-out form containing the statement that it is an application for a transfer.

Section 4: Section 30-79 is hereby added to of Mobile City Code, 1991, as follows:

Sec. 30-79. – Notice of Public Hearing for Alcoholic Beverage License.

a) In every case where application is made for any type of alcohol beverage license, in addition to other advertising requirements that may be required by law, notice of said application shall be published on a website approved for such notice by the City's Department of Revenue. Such notice shall read substantially as follows:

(Name of Applicant) has made application to the City Council of the City of Mobile for a (type of license) for the premises located at (location), Mobile, Alabama. A public hearing will be held by the City Council in the Council's chambers at (time) on the day of ,20 , located at (location).

- (b) In addition to the published notice required, the applicant shall post on the premises where the business or sale is to be conducted, continuously for a period of not less than seven days prior to the consideration of the application by the City Council, a posted notice of the pending application and public hearing concerning the granting thereof in the manner and form to be supplied by the City Revenue Department, at the time application is first made to the City for such license. Such notice shall be conspicuously displayed on the front of the building so as to be clearly visible from the street or sidewalk adjacent thereto.
- (c) Applicant shall take such steps as may be necessary to meet all requirements of ordinances, regulations, and statutes applicable thereto. When the application for a license is made and all requirements have been met, a day for hearing shall be set, the day shall be supplied to the applicant to be inserted in the newspaper ad and in the posted notice.

Section 5: Section 34-22(b) of Mobile City Code, 1991, is hereby amended to read as follows:

In addition to all other penalties, if a taxpayer fails to timely pay the city any sales tax due under the city's sales tax code, there shall be added as interest one (1) percent of the total amount due if the delinquency is not for more than one (1) month, with an additional one (1) percent for each additional month or fraction thereof during which the delinquency continues.

In addition to all other penalties, if a taxpayer fails to timely pay the city any sales tax due under the city's sales tax code, there shall be added interest at a rate determined pursuant to *Ala. Code* Section 40-1-44.

Section 6: Section 34-24(b) of Mobile City Code, 1991, is hereby amended to read as follows:

In addition to all other penalties, if a taxpayer fails to timely pay the city any use tax due under the city's use tax code, there shall be added as interest one (1) percent of the total amount due if the delinquency is not for more than one (1) month, with an additional one (1) percent for each additional month or fraction thereof during which the delinquency continues.

In addition to all other penalties, if a taxpayer fails to timely pay the city any sales tax due under the city's sales tax code, there shall be added interest at a rate determined pursuant to *Ala*. *Code* Section 40-1-44.

Section 7: Section 34-42(e)(1)(f) of Mobile City Code, 1991, is hereby amended to read as follows:

If at any time during the current license year the taxpayer fails to meet any of the above stated criteria, then within ten (10) forty-five (45) days after any of the said criteria have been violated or exceeded, the taxpayer shall purchase all appropriate business licenses from the city for the entire license year and without regard to this subsection.

Section 8: Section 34-60(c) of Mobile City Code, 1991, is hereby amended to read as follows:

All delinquent accounts (both taxes and penalties) shall also be charged simple interest at the rate of one (1) percent per month. All delinquent accounts shall also be charged simple interest at a rate determined by *Ala. Code* Section 40-1-44.

Section 9: Section 34-68(d) of Mobile City Code, 1991, is hereby amended to read as follows:

If the petition is granted or the city or a court otherwise determines that a refund is due, the overpayment shall be promptly refunded to the taxpayer, together with interest to the extent provided for in section 11-51-92. If the city determines that a refund is due, the amount of overpayment plus any interest due thereon may first be credited by the city against any outstanding tax liabilities due and owing by the taxpayer to the city, and the balance of any overpayment shall be promptly refunded to the taxpayer. If any refund or part thereof is credited to any other tax by the city the taxpayer shall be provided with a written detailed statement showing the amount of overpayment, the amount credited for payment to other taxes, and the resulting amount of the refund.

If the petition is granted or the city or a court otherwise determines that a refund is due, the overpayment shall be promptly refunded to the taxpayer, together with interest at a rate determined pursuant to *Ala. Code* Section 40-1-44. If the city or a court determines that a refund is due, the amount of overpayment plus any interest due thereon may first be credited by the city against any outstanding final tax liabilities due and owing by the taxpayer to the city, and the balance of any overpayment shall be promptly refunded to the taxpayer. If any refund or part thereof is credited to any other tax by the city, the taxpayer shall be provided with a written detailed statement showing the amount of overpayment, the amount credited for payment to other taxes, and the amount refunded.

Section 10: Section 34-75(b)

In addition to all other penalties, if a taxpayer fails to timely pay the city and rental motor vehicle tax due under the city's rental motor vehicle tax code, there shall be added as interest one (1) percent of the total amount due if the delinquency is not for more than one (1) month, with an additional one (1) percent for each additional month or fraction thereof during which the delinquency continues.

In addition to all other penalties, if a taxpayer fails to timely pay the city and rental motor vehicle tax due under the city's rental motor vehicle tax code, there shall be added interest at a rate determined pursuant to *Ala. Code* Section 40-1-44.

<u>Section 11:</u> Section 34-105(b)

In addition to other penalties, if a taxpayer fails to timely pay the city any lodging tax due under the city's lodging tax code, there shall be added as interest one (1) percent of the total amount due if the delinquency is not for more than one (1) month, with an additional one (1) percent for each additional month or fraction thereof under which the delinquency continues.

In addition to other penalties, if a taxpayer fails to timely pay the city any lodging tax due under the city's lodging tax code, there shall be added interest at a rate determined pursuant to *Ala. Code* Section 40-1-44.

Section 11: Section 34-137(b) of Mobile City Code, 1991, is hereby amended to read as follows:

In addition to all other penalties, if a taxpayer fails to timely pay the city any lease tax due under the city's tax on lease of tangible personal property code, there shall be added as interest one (1) percent of the total amount due if the delinquency is not for more than one (1) month, with an additional one (1) percent for each additional month or fraction thereof during which the delinquency continues.

In addition to all other penalties, if a taxpayer fails to timely pay the city any lease tax due under the city's tax on lease of tangible personal property code, there shall be added interest at a rate determined pursuant to *Ala. Code* Section 40-1-44.

Section 12: Section 34-44(e) of Mobile City Code, 1991, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Firm identification fee: Every firm employing professionals shall pay an annual firm identification fee in the amount of ten dollars.

Issuance fee: A fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be charged for issuing each annual business license. The fee for issuing each annual business shall be equal to the maximum amount allowable pursuant to State law. (See *Ala. Code* Section 11-51-90).

Section 13: Miscellaneous provisions:

- (a) This Ordinance repeals and replaces Mobile City Ordinance 34-068.
- (b) All other City Code Sections and ordinances or part of any City Code Sections and ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- (c) The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any part of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, that declaration shall not affect the part or parts that remain.
- (d) That the City Clerk of the City of Mobile is hereby authorized and directed to advertise the adoption of this Ordinance as required by law.
- (e) This Ordinance shall be effective within the City of Mobile and its police jurisdiction on January 1, 2023.
